“Wrangler in Training”

Discover your leadership talents and incorporate them into the riding program at Camp Scherman! Find out what being a camp counselor at Camp Scherman is all about. Program planning, camper dynamics, and other interactive skills will be shared while you explore your leadership style. Knowledge of horses and advanced Western riding skills are required.

CIT II

“Counselor in Training”

Continue to develop your leadership style and learn about the challenges and rewards of being a camp counselor. Time will be spent on camp program planning, camper dynamics, problem solving, and enhancing interpersonal skills. Successful completion of CIT I is a prerequisite.

APPRENTICE

The Apprentice program is for girls who have successfully completed CIT I and CIT II and are under age 18. Apprentices spend the summer at camp and focus on a specific program area of interest, have an active role in the units, and learn how camp is run. Apprentice applications must be submitted by 6 p.m. on April 20, 2018. Apprentices may opt to go home over the weekends or stay at camp to interact with Weekend Camps, continuing their leadership journey.
