Gold Award Pin, Regalia, and Notebook Order Information

What is the Girl Scout Gold Award?

The Girl Scout Gold Award is the highest and most prestigious award a girl may earn. The Gold Award pin may only be worn by a recipient of this honor to symbolize the commitment and effort to Take Action by addressing a community need through a Gold Award project.

What does the Girl Scout Council of Orange County provide?

The Girl Scouts of Orange County provides one Gold Award pin, Gold Award Regalia, and a personalized notebook to all Girl Scout Gold Award recipients. Donations are accepted to help cover the cost of the pin, graduation stole, and other Gold Award related expenses. Additional pin(s) and/or graduation stole(s) may be purchased for use in a shadow box or other display or to replace a lost pin/stole.

Who may present the Girl Scout Gold Award?

The Girl Scout Gold Award pin is an official earned award. It may be presented by a parent, Girl Scout advisor, or other community leader as part of the Girl Scout Gold Award ceremony or other appropriate occasion.

How will I get my Gold Award pin, Regalia, and personalized notebook?

Girls must communicate their plans for a ceremony or other celebration to ensure the pin, Regalia, and personalized notebook will be available. If no request is made, the pin, Regalia, and notebook will be mailed to the recipient's home address.

What is the cost of the Gold Award pin and Regalia?

GSOC provides the Girl Scout Gold Award pin and Regalia to each recipient at no charge as recognition for earning the highest award in Girl Scouting. The cost of the pin is \$45 and the cost of the graduation stole is \$25. Donations in any amount to help cover the cost of the pin, Regalia, notebook and other Gold Award related expenses are welcomed.
