



2018 National Young Women of Distinction

National Young Woman of Distinction (NYWOD) is the honor given to ten Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors annually whose Gold Award projects demonstrated extraordinary leadership, had a measurable and sustainable impact, and addressed a local challenge related to a national and/or global issue.

To be eligible to apply for NYWOD, girls:

- Must have completed their Gold Award between April 1, 2017 and March 31, 2018 and have NOT previously applied for the award
- Are nominated by their Girl Scout Council
- Are selected by Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) annually
- Represent GSUSA as speakers at local and national events
- Gain professional public speaking training
- Have the opportunity to reach a larger national audience while highlighting the importance and impact of their Gold Award project
- Are awarded college scholarships and other opportunities to help sustain their Gold Award project
- Are recognized locally and nationally as inspiring leaders to girls around the world and throughout the Girl Scout Movement

Girl Scout councils may select up to three nominees; GSOC Nominees for the current year may be honored at the annual Recognition Event.

A Girl Scout Gold Award recipient who meets the criteria may request a nomination. Interested girls should email <u>mygoldaward@girlscoutsoc.org</u> to request a nomination.

Nominees must have a user account and complete the application including a head shot photo, video, and answers to application questions using <u>Go Gold Online</u>

Councils may nominate candidates from April 1 through April 30 annually. The ten National Young Women of Distinction are announced during the first week of July.
