

Create your Troop Fall Product Team!

Now is the time to recruit your Troop Fall Product team to support your girls in running their Girl Scout nut & magazine business.

Volunteers should complete the membership registration/renewal process and select/renew their role to complete the background screening process in order to supervise girls and/or handle money or products.



Troop Product Coordinator (September – January)

Trains parents, girls, and Fall Product team, manages the sale in the UNIFY software, receives & distributes products to families, collects money & makes deposits, signs troop up for booth sales, receives & distributes rewards to girls. Must have Excel software and be able to use spreadsheets. Trainings will be available online and in-person in September.

Initial Order Pick-Up (Oct 19 -22)

Picks up & signs for initial nut order from Service Unit Distributor. Receives a Troop Helper briefing from Troop Product Coordinator.

Nut Distributor (Oct 19–Nov 3)

Assists Troop Product Coordinator to distribute nuts to parents & girls and helps with tracking by using receipts.

Booth Sale Helper (Oct 25–Nov 3)

Supervises girls, products & money at a fall booth sale in a retail shopping center. Must complete online Booth Sale training.

Cupboard Pick-Up (Oct 22–Nov 3)

Picks up & signs for products from the cupboards for Troop. Must receive a Troop Helper briefing from the Troop Product Coordinator.
