

# Go-Getter Award



## Description:

What is a Go-Getter? A Go-Getter is a volunteer who expresses vision, ambition, and persists through challenges.

## Criteria:

- Volunteer abides by the Girl Scout Promise and Law (at any level, troop helpers, troop leaders, or service unit team members).
- Registered Girl Scout member, successfully completed background screening (where applicable) and completed appropriate training for their volunteer role.
- Volunteer either works directly with girls, adults, or both.
- More than one volunteer can earn each award.
- Volunteers can only be awarded one letter per year but over time can strive to collect all four.

## Examples:

- A troop volunteer who encourages and empowers their Girl Scout Juniors to take on and achieve a stand out Bronze Award project that is shared at the Service Unit meeting by girls.
- A new Troop Cookie Manager who stepped up and helped all of the girls reach their cookie sale goals using the 5 skills and has exceeded their per girl average over the year before.
- A volunteer who worked with their troop to plan a new recruitment event for the Service Unit for the first time.
