

Innovator Award



Description:

What is an Innovator? An Innovator can solve problems with creativity, curiosity, and resourcefulness.

Criteria:

- Volunteer abides by the Girl Scout Promise and Law (at any level, troop helpers, troop leaders, or service unit team members).
- Registered Girl Scout member, successfully completed background screening (where applicable) and completed appropriate training for their volunteer role.
- Volunteer either works directly with girls, adults, or both.
- More than one volunteer can earn each award.
- Volunteers can only be awarded one letter per year but over time can strive to collect all four.

Examples:

- A troop leader who goes beyond the Journey curricula and creates new ways for girls to help them develop their skills and achieve their goals.
- A volunteer who creates, implements, or expands a STEM event, workshop or series for the service unit, their region, or Girl Scouts of Orange County.
- A volunteer who uses new ideas for technology in a creative way to improve or enhance their Girl Scout experience and/or service unit engagement.
