

Orange Owl

DESCRIPTION:

The Orange Owl Award is a Girl Scouts of Orange County Council recognition and is given only by a Service Unit. Awardees of the Orange Owl will be presented with the certificate and pin at a Service Unit event or meeting. This award is the prerequisite for the Spotlight Award.



CRITERIA:

- Registered member of Girl Scouts.
- Completed training for volunteer position(s) held.
- Given to volunteers who have consistently given outstanding service to Girl Scouting in their Service Unit.
- Specific examples of the nominee's outstanding service are noted in the nomination.

NOMINATION:

The nomination for the Orange Owl is completed via Email Me Form. This is a Council Award and is presented at Service Unit level. GSOC will provide the Service Unit with a certificate and pin.

EXAMPLE:

Melissa stepped up to be the School Liaison this year for a school we have struggled with. She works to establish connections and support for new start-up troops at St. Annes. She has also supported school specific cookie booths.
