

Spotlight Award

DESCRIPTION:

The Spotlight Award is a Girl Scouts of Orange County Council recognition. Awardees must have previously received the Orange Owl. This award is presented by the Service Unit.



CRITERIA:

- Registered member of Girl Scouts.
- Completed training for volunteer position(s) held.
- Given to volunteers who have previously received the Orange Owl and continued to give outstanding service to the Service Unit.
- Specific examples of the nominee's outstanding service are noted in the nomination.

NOMINATION:

The nomination for the Spotlight Award is completed via Email Me Form. This is a Council Award and is presented at a Service Unit meeting. Service Units may select one Spotlight Award recipient each year.

EXAMPLE:

Sandy is an active member of the service unit team and has volunteered for multiple positions for the past three years. She has been the SU Cookie Distributor and an integral part of the SU Mega Cookie Delivery team by providing timely and thorough communication to the TCC's securing volunteers and ensuring all troops successfully picked up cookies. Sandy also volunteered to be part of the fall product team as SU Nut Distributor. She completed training, secured a pickup location and delivery time and created a pickup plan within the COVID-19 guidelines. Due to Sandy's guidance, the nut delivery and distribution was a success, and all troops received the product they ordered.
