



Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center – Frequently Asked Questions

Located in Newport Beach’s Marina Park, the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center (GSLC) serves Orange County’s 21,000 Girl Scouts as the hub for Girl Scout STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) programs.

Girls create lifelong memories while exploring the Balboa Peninsula, kayaking from the bayfront property, and toasting marshmallows for S’mores on the sprawling patio as the sun sets over the ocean.

Visiting the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center

Where is the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center (GSLC) located?

The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center is located at 200 18th Street, Newport Beach, CA 92661 (corner of 18th Street and Bay Ave.).

How do I park at the GSLC?

Parking space is limited and carpooling is highly recommended. Available parking in front of the building and in the Marina Park parking lot is not guaranteed. Please use the mobile parking app [Parkmobile](#) (available for Android and iPhone) to pay for parking. If you do not wish to download the app, use the stationary pay station located on site at Marina Park.

How do I make a reservation for my troop at the GSLC?

The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center is reserved for the sole use of Orange County Girl Scouts. Visit www.girlscoutsoc.org/GSLC to make a reservation for your Orange County troop at the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center.

Your troop has the option to make a reservation for your recurring troop meetings or to stay overnight at the GSLC. All GSLC overnight reservations run from 2:00 pm until 12:00 noon the next day. Bring your popcorn and s'mores fixings

How can I visit the GSLC if I am not a member of Girl Scouts of Orange County?

The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center is reserved for the sole use of Girl Scouts of Orange County members. Reservations are not currently available to non-GSOC visitors. The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center is named in honor of philanthropist and community leader, Julia Argyros. Ambassador and Mrs. George L. Argyros provided Girl Scouts of Orange County with a generous and historic \$2.5 million presenting donor gift to bring the Leadership Center to Orange County Girl Scouts. Girls can't be what they don't see. The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center boldly addresses the shortage of female leaders by providing Orange County's nearly 21,000 Girl Scouts and 13,000 volunteers and adult members a state-of-the-art, safe learning environment where girls embrace challenges and expand their world by exploring 21st century careers and learning to take action that has a sustainable impact. They also have the opportunity to create lifelong memories while enjoying the waterfront surroundings of the Balboa Bay Peninsula.

Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center Facility

What facilities are offered at the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center (GSLC)?

The building features two large program areas, Innovate and Explore, separated by a spacious atrium with views to the bay. The Leadership Center has a 2,000 sq. ft. patio (with a gas fire ring for making S'mores), kayaks, personal flotation devices, and paddle storage. The facility is equipped with a kitchen, bathroom, and shower facilities to accommodate overnight visits.

Is the GSLC a green building?

Yes! The Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center is designed to be a Silver level LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) building and will feature Girl Scout-created artwork on permanent display highlighting the building's energy efficiencies.

How is the building funded?

The City of Newport Beach unanimously approved a \$1-per-year, 50-year ground lease in June of 2013. With the ground lease approved, Girl Scouts of Orange County launched a \$5M Comprehensive Campaign to fund construction of the building and provide an operational endowment.
