TRUE NORTH YOUTH LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE – FAQS

When and where is the event?

The True North Conference takes place on **Saturday, January 10, 2026, at Chapman University** in Orange, CA., from **10:00a to 3:00p**

What is True North Youth Leadership Conference?

True North Conference is for Girl Scouts in **grades 6–12** to gain insight and inspiration learning about careers, as well as hands-on life skills games, award earning, and alumni conversations about college life.

What is the schedule like?

The day includes an inspiring keynote, interactive award workshop, Reality Town, alum chats, and networking. The event ends with a closing session to celebrate earning the **True North Award**.

Do I need to bring lunch or is it provided?

Snacks are provided, but **lunch is not included** with registration. There is an option to preorder a boxed lunch for a small fee. Vegetarian options are available. You may bring your own lunch & snacks.

What should participants wear?

It is recommended that Girl Scouts wear their **vest or sash** with comfortable, school-appropriate clothing and shoes for walking between sessions.

Why was the name changed for this event?

The event now aligns with GSUSA's new True North Award, a **prerequisite for Silver/Gold Awards**, while still inspiring girls through career exploration, skill-building, and alum chats. Participants earn the True North Award during the conference.

Which award will Girl Scouts earn?

Girl Scouts will earn the **True North Award** for their level, included with registration.

Will the True North Award be earned at the event?

All steps required for the award are built into the conference. Girls will leave with the True North Award completed as part of their experience.

Is this event an annual event for GSOC?

Yes! The True North Conference happens annually, with new speakers, mentors, alum panelists, and Reality Town scenarios that give girls fresh insights and growth each time they attend. **We recommend attending every year.**

Is there a service project at this event?

We are hosting an optional “accessories drive” for [Working Wardrobes](#) employ/reentry program.

What should participants bring?

A refillable water bottle, and an accessory item for the service project (scarves, ties, handbags, jewelry, etc. for Working Wardrobes).

Is this event lecture style or interactive?

This event is hands-on, interactive, and as high energy as a Girl Scout pursuing her dreams! Girls will have many chances to ask questions, develop plans, create relationships and more.

Do adults attend too?

This is a **girl-focused program**. Troop leaders or caregivers are not part of the sessions, but adults who wish to engage can register (free) as event volunteers.

Are girls supervised if they attend independently?

Independent participants (Juliettes or girls not attending with their troop) will be placed in small cohorts with Girl Scout volunteers and staff leading rotations.
