Each set contains information for earning <u>five</u> skill building badges and includes steps and choices for girls, tips for leaders, suggestions for giving service, and ideas for how to tie activities to a Girl Scout leadership journey.

To earn the badges, girls complete detailed steps found in the Badge Activity Set. Each badge has five steps with three activity choices. Girls may choose to do all of the activities they are interested in or just pick one or two of the three choices within each step.

Girls may choose to earn a badge related to their journey or to any area that they are interested in. By exploring leadership through journey activities and building skills by earning badges, girls experience the benefits of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.



View the world with a web journalist's eyes, and you'll find the story in everything. Build yourself a safe space online, where you can show your readers what moves you and share stories and causes with friends. You might end up getting to know yourself a little better, too.

- Step 1: Find a worthwhile subject for your website or blog
- Step 2: Be the host with the most
- Step 3: Build a blueprint
- Step 4: Create must-see content
- Step 5: Go live then drive!

When girls earn this badge, they'll know how to design, build, and promote their own website.

Women's Health

Nothing's more important than good health—and, as a woman, we have unique health issues at every stage of our lives. How can you make the health decisions that are right for you, and what kinds of support are out there to guide you? Do this badge to find out! Identify health topics facing women in your community and across the globe, explore those that matter most to you, and—in the last step—reach out and raise awareness to spread good health to the women in your world.

- Step 1: Investigate the tests that help women stay healthy
- Step 2: Find out how fads and beauty practices impact health Step 3: Focus on techniques to help you stay emotionally healthy

Step 4: Take a closer look at a women's health issue Step 5: Get the word out on a women's health topic When girls earn this badge, they'll know how women can lead healthy lives.

Troupe Performer

Performance is a powerful way to make an impact on an audience—and a perfect way to put your leadership into action. It's also a fun way to sharpen your communication skills, learn to handle stress with grace, strengthen your teamwork skills, and grow relationships and networks. Get out there and show your stuff—put on a show! **Step 1**: Pick your performance style Step 2: Find and develop material Step 3: Rehearse! Step 4: Launch your performance

Science of Style

Imagine farming silkworms to make raw silk, engineering a biodegradable fabric, or using chemistry to develop a coverup that hides and heals acne scars. Fashion and beauty are glamorous businesses, but it's the science behind these industries that makes their products cutting edge and desirable. In this badge, use the science of style to create—and imagine—your own products.

- Step 1: Test skin care and makeup
- **Step 2**: Examine the science behind fabrics and accessories
- Step 3: Explore the science behind hair products and perfume
- Step 4: Investigate the sociology of style
- Step 5: Formulate future style

When girls earn this badge, they'll know the science behind makeup, perfume, fashion fabrics, and skin care products.

Novelist

Share a meal with a historical figure, unearth ancient treasures, spend the summer in outer space or dancing flamenco in Spain—writing a novel lets you dream the world your way. As you write descriptions and dialogue, invent situations, and make up feelings, you'll experience the fun of a novelist's career: spending time with new friends (characters you've created) and in other worlds (those from your imagination). And you'll end up with something impressive to share in college admissions—a work of fiction you wrote yourself.

- Step 1: Deconstruct a novel
- Step 2: Create great characters
- Step 3: Develop a plot
- Step 4: Write at least 20 pages
- Step 5: Edit your pages

When girls earn this badge, they'll know what it takes to write a great novel and have written at least 20 pages of their own.

Textile Artist

When you see all the colors and textures of fabrics and yarns, do you dream up a million things to do with them? Get ready to turn those visions into reality as you meet with artists, learn about the world of textile arts, and make two projects in the craft that most inspires you to pick up your needles (or loom or spinning wheel).

- Step 1: Choose your textile art
- Step 2: Find your tools and materials
- Step 3: Learn the basics
- Step 4: Make something for everyday use

Step 5: Create a gift or item for a special occasion When girls earn this badge, they'll have learned the basics of a textile art - and have two fantastic projects to show for it.

Room Makeover

Combine color, texture, glue, and paint to develop some serious DIY flair! Look around for a room that inspires you (a bedroom, study nook, corner of a family room) and use this badge to discover the design concepts and fix-it tactics needed to turn a simple space into a creative statement.

- Step 1: Gather ideas and inspiration
- Step 2: Paint something
- Step 3: Sew or glue something
- Step 4: Redo something
- Step 5: Build something

Truth Seeker

We're often told that we live in the age of information. It's true that we're surrounded by data-from TV, the Internet, and our friends. But not all information is created equal. Some is misleading, and some is downright wrong. It's important to know how to uncover the truth in what we see and hear, to judge sources on credibility, accuracy, reasonableness, and support for their claims. In this badge, you'll find out how to separate fact from fiction.

Put your outdoor skills to the test-and gain some new ones-as you become a Girl Scout Senior Adventurer.

- Step 4: Plan your service to the great outdoors Step 5: Capture the adventure

Car Care

Driving is an exciting step toward independence, a chance to have fun going new places-and a big responsibility. In this badge, you'll master maintenance tips that keep a car in top form and driving skills that will help you rule the road safely.

- Step 1: Get a handle on basic car maintenance
- Step 2: Investigate vehicle safety
- Step 3: Research safe driving practices
- Step 4: Find out what to do in case of emergency
- Step 5: Drive for a greener world
