

Cookie Cupboard Manager

PURPOSE OF POSITION: To manage the receipt, storage and distribution of cookies to Troops/Groups.

TERM: Appointed by the GSOC Product Program Director for duration of the program.

TIME COMMITMENT: January to mid-March 3–5 days per week, schedule flexible

ACCOUNTABLE TO: GSOC Product Program Director

SUPPORTED BY: Product Program Team

RESPONSIBILITIES:

• Participate in Cookie Cupboard Management training.

- Direct the operation of the Cupboard within the assigned area and provide space to house product.
- Take delivery of cookies as needed throughout the program.
- Confirm each troop's order, pick-up date and time via email.
- Distribute cookies during set published hours and days.
- Enter and commit all transfers of cookies in the cookie software within 24-48 hours after Troop pick-up.
- Complete daily inventory, balancing cookies in hand with inventory count maintained in cookie software.
- Maintain <u>daily</u> communication with the Product Program team during program period to always ensure adequate stock and balanced inventory on hand.
- Record any damaged cookies received into cookie software.
- Assist with cookie movement between Cupboard locations as needed.
- Complete end of program final reports to be submitted with receipts when Cupboard is closed.
- Completes all GSOC registration requirements and training required for this role

QUALITIES REQUIRED:

- **Commitment to Focus on Girls:** Understands that girls experience the Girl Scout Leadership model through using girl-led, cooperative-learning and learning-by-doing activities.
- **Confidentiality and Conflict Resolution:** Exercises discretion, integrity and impartiality in dealing with Service Unit personnel issues.
- Ability to Foster Diversity: Understands and embraces differences.
- Communication Skills: Expresses ideas clearly and concisely.
- Model the Girl Scout Promise and Law: Demonstrates personal integrity, credibility and dependability for girls and a commitment to the mission, goals, guidelines, policies and standards of GSUSA and GSOC
