We are excited about the new membership year starting October 2023. We would like to remind you of a few requirements to complete by September 30, 2023 to start off the New Membership Year successfully:

- 1. Renew your membership before September 30, 2023.
- 2. Complete Mandated Reporter training, upload a certificate in gsLearn, or register for training on the calendar. This is required by law to be a volunteer with Girl Scouts of Orange County.
- 3. Arrange for Fingerprinting. This is also a state mandated

requirement to volunteer with Girl Scouts of Orange County.
