Girl Scout Bridging at the Disneyland® Resort - FAQ

Are Disneyland reservations included for this event?

Yes! You do not have to worry about getting your own reservation! Every ticket registered with this event will include a reservation for the event day, starting in California Adventure, with the ability to change parks.

Does my whole troop need to attend for my daughter to go?

You are encouraged to attend this event even if only a few girls, or one girl, from your troop wants to go. Whole troops are also welcome. Troops and individuals are responsible for appropriate adult-girl ratios. This is not a drop-off event; must limit adult registration to 2-3.

We are a multilevel troop can our girls from other levels attend also?

You are welcome to register all members of your troop for the same price as the bridging. Girls not bridging may cheer on their sister Girl Scouts as they bridge! All Girl Scouts registered for this event will receive the same benefits including the bridging patch.

Do I get to attend the Bridging Ceremony with my daughter?

All paid adult and bridging girl participants are welcome, and stay together for the event. Please limit adult registration to 2-3 per troop.

Do I still need to pay if I am a Disneyland Resort Magic Key holder?

Yes, the cost of the exclusive Bridging Ceremony and Disney program includes a One Day Park Hopper® ticket. The price is the same without a ticket. Magic Key Holders are welcome to join up with participants following the event.

Can other family members attend the Bridging Ceremony and S.W.A.P.S. Exchange?

In order for this event to be available to as many Girl Scouts as possible, we must **limit attendees to Girl Scouts and 2 Troop Leaders/designated adults.** Additional family members may meet up with you in California Adventure Park after the event concludes at 8:00am.

What time will the ceremony and S.W.A.P.S. exchange be?

All participants should arrive at the parking structure by 6:00 am, and check-in for the exclusive bridging ceremony at Disney California Adventure® Park will begin at 6:30 am (before the park opens). Check-in will be followed by bridging in the park, which will conclude at about 8:00 am, at which time all participants will be on their own to enjoy Disney California Adventure® and Disneyland® for the rest of the day. All event offerings and timing are subject to change.



When and where can I use my ticket?

All tickets included with the event are valid on the day of the event only, at Disney California Adventure® and at Disneyland® after park hopping opens.

Do we need to bring S.W.A.P.S.?

YES! We strongly encourage you to bring 50-75 S.W.A.P.S. The S.W.A.P.S. Exchange is part of the bridging program.

Is food included?

Buffet breakfast will be available during the event time. Participants are responsible for any meals after the event ends. Please communicate allergies to servers.

Is parking included?

Will there be a patch included?

Yes, each participant will receive a GSOC Disneyland Bridging event patch AND a collectible pin!

What is the goal of this event?

The goal of this event is for ALL Girl Scouts to participate in a memorable bridging ceremony and cerebration! Daisies completing 1st grade bridge to Brownies; Brownies completing 3rd grade bridge to Juniors; Juniors completing 5th grade bridge to Cadettes; Cadettes completing 8th grade bridge to Seniors; Seniors completing 10th grade bridge to Ambassadors; and Ambassadors completing 12th grade bridge to Adult.
