SUGGESTED SUPPLIES

One Warm Coat project



Gently worn coats should be
clean and wearable.

Objective: One Warm Coat is a service providing free coats to children and adults in need while promoting volunteerism and environmental sustainability. Girl Scouts will collect and donate coats for the One Warm Coat drive. Girls will also make happy “pocket notes” to go into the pocket of each coat donated. Girls may make more notes than coats donated. Extra notes will be sent to the One Warm Coat drive, where troop volunteers will place the notes into the pockets of extra donated coats.

The unprecedented crisis created by the COVID-19 pandemic is impacting the lives of millions of people. Families who were already struggling are now at severe risk, and many will be unable to pay their utility bills. The need for coats this fall and winter will be greater than ever before.

Printout:

Print note card, one-sided, white or light-color paper or cardstock, 8 ½ x 11, for two folded notes, two per page. Print more if you would like to make more notes. Printing in color is helpful, but not required.

Art materials:

Any art supplies you have: crayons, markers, pens, colored pencils, glitter, paint pens, bright colors etc.

At least one warm coat for donation, any size, any style. Please ensure that the coat you are donating does not have any holes or stains. You may donate more than one warm coat.
