Girl Member of the Global Action Team (GAT) Position Description

PURPOSE OF POSITION: To ensure the voice of girls is heard as the GAT conducts its work, act as a representative for girls in the leadership of GAT and to advocate for Girl Scouting in the community.

TERM: Appointed by Global Action Team (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022)

AVERAGE TIME COMMITMENT: 1.5hr Monthly meeting and additional 4 - 6hrs average monthly on committee work and events, does not include potential travel or large events/series planning

ACCOUNTABLE TO: Accountable to the Global Action Volunteer (GAV) and Staff Partner

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Prepare for and attend GAT meetings as scheduled. This may include reading, presentation prep, and/or other groundwork. Meetings are typically held the first Tuesday of each month at 4:30pm 6pm.
- 2. Communicate girl perspective to GAT at meetings and sub-group work.
- 3. Serve in a leadership/team capacity for majority of special events, travel trips and additional money earning projects as available.
- 4. Work alongside GAT to create, facilitate, present and evaluate activities throughout the year.
- 5. Advocate for Girl Scouts in the community, and work with GAT to promote a Global Girl Scout perspective and help create excitement for council travel patrols.
- 6. Support the GAT in being inclusive of all Girl Scouts and leaders, and to have a global understanding of cultivating and engaging girls and leaders.
- 7. Performs other duties as delegated.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Register as a girl member of the Girl Scout of Orange County.
- 2. Accepts and adheres to the purpose and principles of the Girl Scout Movement.
- 3. Possess leadership and communication skills to work harmoniously with adults and girl members.
- 4. Ability to keep supervisor informed and aware of activities and/or problems with area of work.
- 5. Demonstrate commitment to the GAT, as well as the mission, policies, standards and goals of GSOC.
- 6. Willingness to work with persons regardless of age, race, disability, religion, ethnic or socioeconomic background; accepts the beliefs and principles of the Girl Scout Movement.
- 7. Must be a high school aged Girl Scout at the Senior or Ambassador level.
