National Leadership Journeys (*It's Your Story – Tell It!*, *It's Your Planet – Love It!* and *It's Your World – Change It!*) Each series has separate books and awards for Girl Scouts at each grade level and a corresponding adult guide.

The Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting where girls and adults can learn about exciting new badges, bridging, Bronze/Silver/Gold Awards, Girl Scout history and traditions and much more!

Complemented by the Girl Scout Cookie program, Girl Scout travel and Girl Scout awards, the National Program Portfolio is designed to help girls develop as leaders and build confidence by learning new skills. It also ensures that Girl Scouts at every level share a powerful, national experience. It's about girls together changing the world!
