# Girl Scout Gold Award

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Who can earn the Girl Scout Gold Award?**

*A girl in grades 9-12 who is a registered Girl Scout Senior or Ambassador can earn the Gold Award.*

### **Where do I start?**

*Complete two Journeys for your level (including a Journey Take Action Project) OR have earned the Girl Scout Silver Award and complete one Journey for your level (including a Journey Take Action Project.) Your Journeys are good practice for choosing the issue you want to address to earn the Gold Award. When you're ready to start tracking your progress and develop your project plan for your Gold Award project, create an account and submit your Project Proposal for your Girl Scout Gold Award Take Action Project using [GoGold](#).*

### **When do I interview?**

*Before starting the project, girls MUST participate in an interview with a Gold Award Support Team Liaison and obtain approval. Interviews are scheduled between 5:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. on the dates above; appointments are assigned and girls receive notification after the deadline and before the interview date. Project Proposals are received on an ongoing basis according to the schedule above; Project Proposals received after the deadline are held until the next deadline.*

### **What do I do after my project?**

*After the project, girls MUST complete the Final Report (Steps 6 & 7). Final Reports are received on an ongoing basis according to the schedule dates; Final Reports received after the deadline are held until the next deadline. A girl must obtain final approval from her Gold Award Support Team Liaison to be considered a Gold Award Girl Scout. Once final approval is given, a congratulatory email is sent to the girl and her name is added to the list for requests of certificates and letters from public officials. Girls planning to participate in a May-June ceremony should use the March deadline to allow time for council staff to obtain letters and certificates prior to the ceremony.*

### **How will I be recognized?**

*All girls complete the Girl Scout Gold Award Profile (a link will be sent to the girl) and take a picture for the Girl Scout Gold Award Honor Wall, [Highest Awards Yearbook](#), and social media recognition. Refer to [Girl Scout Gold Award Picture Days](#) for information about the annual GSOC hosted Gold Award Picture Day or visit [www.liveshoot1.com](http://www.liveshoot1.com) to make an appointment for any scheduled date.*

### **What does GSOC provide?**

*GSOC provides the Girl Scout Gold Award Materials including the Girl Scout Gold Award pin, Gold Award Regalia, Gold Award yard sign, and personalized notebook (containing certificates and letters from public officials) to recognize each OC Gold Award Girl Scout. Girls/families are invited to make a donation to help offset this cost to recognize girls. Girls MUST have completed the Girl Scout Gold Award prior to planning to participate in a Girl Scout Gold Award ceremony. It is the responsibility of the girl/family/troop leader or other Girl Scout adult to make arrangements with council staff to receive award materials prior to a planned troop, community, or regional ceremony/presentation of the pin using the Girl Scout Gold Award Pin Request Order Form. If no request is made, Gold Award materials will be mailed to the girl at her home address. In addition, a special Girl Scout Gold Award Miniature Pin is available to honor significant adults.*
