When Girl Scouts take action they **develop important skills that help prepare them to earn the Bronze, Silver, and Gold Awards** – the Highest Awards in Girl Scouting. These awards encourage girls to find a cause they care about and **take action** to make sustainable change.

In Girl Scouts, when a girl completes a **Take Action** project, she teams up with others to:

- Identify a problem
- Brainstorm solutions
- Create a plan
- Put the plan into action
- Talk about what she learned – and what she can't wait to do next!

Girl Scout Cadettes want to make a difference in the world – and have fun doing it. They work individually or with a group to create a plan and **Take Action**. They earn Journey Awards and the Girl Scout Silver Award. As they plan and implement their project, they demonstrate an understanding of sustainability while striving to make an impact. **Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors** are seen as community leaders and **take action** to serve as advocates for issues they care about. They develop project management, time management, and communication skills as they partner with agencies. They earn Journey Awards and the Girl Scout Gold Award. Their project includes a plan to ensure sustainability.

Girl Scout Juniors care about others and their communities when they team up with friends to **Take Action** and make a difference. They earn Journey Awards and the Girl Scout Bronze Award. With the help of Girl Scout adults, they develop an understanding of sustainability by talking about how solutions can be lasting.

Girl Scout Daisies learn interesting things, have fun with friends, and try new things to make the world a better place. They **take action** to earn Journey Awards and Daisy Petals which help them understand how to be friendly and helpful.



Girl Scout Brownies discover what matters to them, connect with other Brownies, and take action to make a difference. They earn Journey Awards which help them explore the three keys of leadership—Discover, Connect, and Take Action!
