What does this mean for your Girl Scout?

She's part of a unique organization that provides the tools, opportunities, and support to prepare her for a lifetime of leadership. By participating in our four Program Pillars (STEM, Life Skills, Outdoors, and Entrepreneurship), she is 20% more likely to be a digital leader and twice as likely to become a community problem solver and participate in civic engagement activities. For those who attended camp, 97% say it helped them improve their outdoor skills. 91% of our Girl Scouts want to be entrepreneurs in the future and are learning the confidence and skills to be successful.



Girl Scouts nationally has pledged to bring 2.5 million girls into the **STEM** pipeline by 2025. We are developing the next generation of female leaders in STEM.


Frequently Asked Questions

I already pay \$35 for Membership dues and additional dues to my troop. Why am I being asked to donate?

Of your \$35 Membership dues, \$25 goes directly to Girl Scouts of the USA and a \$10 Council Service Fee supports the operation of our Orange County Girl Scout Council. Troop dues are determined by each troop and do not directly support the council. For Girl Scouts of Orange County to deliver the best programs for girls, additional dollars are needed to support the many programs, trainings and assistance we provide to reach ALL girls. Funds from the Fund Her Success campaign provide financial assistance to our members. As a 501(c)(3) non-profit, we depend on additional support from our members, supporters, corporations, and foundations to provide enriching girl-led programs, volunteer training and support. Your contributions also help sustain GSOC's member facilities, including our four program centers, the Argyros Girl Scout Leadership Center in Newport Beach, and our award-winning Camp Scherman. Your donation to Girl Scouts through the Fund Her Success campaign, makes it possible for us develop the talent and leadership skills in every Girl Scout, so she can grow up to be a confident woman who makes the world a better place.

My daughter participates in the Entrepreneurship Program by selling Cookies and Fall Product and I volunteer my time, so why give more?

We appreciate your time as a volunteer and thank you for your daughter's participation in our entrepreneurship programs. She is developing entrepreneurial leadership and business skills (goal setting, decision making, money management, people skills and business ethics) that will last a lifetime. While a majority of GSOC's revenue is raised from product sales, the council service fee and the Shop, GSOC invests \$654 annually per girl to cover the cost of her Girl Scout experience. We deeply thank you for your time and talent. The combination of volunteer support, revenue from product sales and donations ensure that Girl Scouting is available and affordable for every girl in Orange County – today and tomorrow.
