

President's Award

DESCRIPTION:

The President's Award recognizes the efforts of a Service Unit team or program delivery team. This award is approved by the GSOC Adult Recognition Committee (ARC), with final approval from the Board of Directors. Awardees of the President's Award will be presented with the award at Girl Scouts of Orange County's annual recognition event. There is one endorsement required for this award in addition to the nomination.



CRITERIA:

- Registered members of Girl Scouts.
- Completed training for volunteer position(s) held.
- This award recognizes the efforts of a Service Unit team or program delivery team in moving an area or audience toward achievement of the Council's goals during a fiscal or membership year.
- Specific examples of the how the nominee meets the criteria are noted in the nomination and endorsement.

NOMINATION:

The nomination and endorsement for the President's Award is completed via Email Me Form. This is a National Award and the President's Award is presented at GSOC's annual recognition event. GSOC provides a certificate to each member of the team who is awarded the President's Award *and* the team is posted to a plaque that is hanging in the lobby at the Girl Scouts of Orange County Headquarters in Irvine.

EXAMPLE:

This committee was on task and cohesive from the beginning. The 2018 parade was the first time in several years Girl Scouts were represented in the City of HB July 4th parade and the committee had a goal to host a float in 2019. The girls wanted it and with the great communication, follow through, and hard work of this committee and several other troop volunteers, they were able to set a goal and achieve in a fashion that not only exceeded everyone's expectations, from keeping costs low to making areas of the event girl-led when possible. Overall this event was fun for the girls. This committee was able to provide a fantastic event for over 75 girls who learned skills during the planning process.
